

Hall of Fame

The Innovation Institute for Fan Experience (IIFX) began in 2020 as a collaborative effort between leaders and members of the international sport & entertainment industry.

IIFX has a dual-focus value proposition:

- Provide sports & entertainment industry members with unmatched opportunities to promote the physical, cybersecurity, and safety of their fans, spectators, attendees, communities, and organizations to access a trusted international network of thought leaders, advanced practitioners, and subject matter experts from the public and private sectors.
- Provide government stakeholders at the local, state, and Federal levels with opportunities to collaborate and to provide expertise and experience in support of the industry to ensure safe and secure events

Purpose of Hall of Fame Award

To create an esteemed place of recognition for individuals in the international sports & entertainment industry who have distinguished themselves through singularly exceptional contributions to the industry over a sustained period of time.

Induction occurs at the IIFX Annual FANCENTRIC International Conference & Expo.

The Hall of Fame is memorialized in a virtual setting on the IIFX website.

The Hall of Fame Award recognizes distinguished meritorious service within the international sports & entertainment industry.

The Hall of Fame Award honors people whose dedication and outstanding efforts have significantly contributed above and beyond to the advancement of the industry and the ideals of the IIFX program.

Those nominated for the Hall of Fame Award are people whose contributions have surpassed others in advancing the sports & entertainment industry.

Nominations should include specific examples of initiatives, innovations, leadership, and other efforts in which the individual has demonstrated an important and sustained role towards the advancement of the profession of Sports & Entertainment and the industry.

Nominations are submitted by members of the sports & entertainment industry to IIFX.

Eligibility Criteria Hall of Fame Award

The criteria for induction into the Hall of Fame is as follows:

LONGEVITY TO INDUSTRY: The nominee has served a minimum of 20 years in the international sports & entertainment industry and/or public safety. Such service /contribution should be enduring (over a long period) and truly significant. (Specific examples)

SUSTAINED PERFORMANCE & CONTRIBUTIONS: The nominee's career is characterized by distinguished service and their service has made significant, positive contributions to the sports & entertainment industry. (Service)

INSPIRATIONAL LEADERSHIP: The nominee is widely respected by their peers and viewed as a leader /good ambassador for the sports & entertainment industry. The nominee should serve as a role model for future industry leaders.

FAN/SPECTATOR CENTRIC: The nominee's contributions should reflect a commitment to service excellence for fan/spectators, and their health, safety, and security. Their work should enhance the fan experience. (Specific Examples)

MANAGEMENT & VISION: The nominee should be instrumental in developing and building a successful sport or entertainment program. Their leadership may include multiple accomplishments over their career with different organizations. Their leadership should be an integral part of overall program success and excellence.

BUSINESS ETHICS: The nominee's conduct throughout their career should reflect integrity, selfless service, and excellence consistent with the highest standard of business ethics.

IIFX Awards Committee Charter Policy

The mission of the IIFX Awards Committee is to review nominations and select annual Award winner(s) to recognize their outstanding contributions to the sports & entertainment industry.

The Awards Committee Chair is appointed by the IIFX Director. The Committee is selected by the Committee Chair and approved by the IIFX Director.

- The Chair shall serve a term of one year, and may be requested to serve an additional , consecutive, term.
- No person shall serve more than two terms as Chair.
- The Committee shall consist of no more than nine members, including the Chair.
- No organization shall be represented by more than one Committee member in any given year.
- The Chair will select a Vice-Chair and a Secretary from the Committee members.
- Committee member terms are limited to three consecutive years.
- Committee members may not submit award nominations.
- Current Committee members are not eligible to receive an Award for accomplishments achieved during an Awards cycle in which they participated as a member of the Committee but may be nominated during subsequent Awards cycles.
- Committee members shall not disclose to parties outside the Committee the names of nominees, the number of nominees, or any information about the process of Award selection.
- All award nominations shall be published on iifx.org after Awards have been announced and shall remain published there.
