Participation in TECH Speed Match Activity

The Innovation Institute for Fan Experience (IIFX) will offer a TECH Speed Match during the Sports & Entertainment Technology Expo.

What is a TECH Speed Match?

The TECH Speed Match is a formal, structured process to encourage sports & entertainment executives, integrators, and consultants to meet new, potential solution partners in a short time.

Process

All qualified sports & entertainment solution providers are present in a large room. Sports & entertainment executives, integrators, and consultants will meet with solution providers for six (6) minutes. A bell will be sounded for the executives, integrators, and consultants to move to their right for the next match meeting. At the end of the Speed Match activity, attendees submit to IIFX a list of individuals and companies to share their contact information with for future meetings and discussions.
